I am a Past Master, Past First Principal, Past Grand Superintendent, Past Sovereign Master, Past Celebrant, Past President, and am or have been a member of almost every masonic body in existence currently. I am also involved in a number of other esoteric societies allied to Masonry.

I was the Founding Master of Peace Council No.224, and a Founder of Northern Equinox Council, both of which I am currently the Secretary of. I was able to bring the Hermetic Chapter of the Spiritual Knight to Canada for the first time in 2018. Further, I have introduced the SRIA in Northern BC, and have been a founder of a new Council of the Cryptic Rite in the Peace Country.

Having been privileged to be the Editor of the Architect for the last 6 years, I have managed to grow our content significantly. As an active researcher I have given over 150 papers and publications on Masonic subjects, as well as produced a number of translations from both Russian and French, and have also edited the Transactions of the SRIA Province of BC and Yukon for the last 7 years.

My leadership positions in Masonry include Deputy Grand Master for the Allied Masonic Degrees of Canada, past DDGM of District 4 AMD, past Grand Superintendent of District 10 of the Supreme Grand Chapter of BC & Yukon (Grand First Principals Award), I am the Chief Adept of the SRIA in Western Canada, and the Director-General of Studies for this most learned Masonic society. and sit on the General Purposes Committee.

As a member of the Royal Order of Eri in England, and maintaining many active memberships in the UK, I am able to further actively strengthen and build friendships and active collaboration between our respective Grand Jurisdictions through my connections.
