From the Inaugural Address of M. Ven.. Bro. Fletcher

Brethren,

I stand here today on the shoulders of giants. My heartfelt thanks are due to M. Ven. Bro. Prince Selvaraj for his trust and sponsorship a decade ago; I would not be here if it was not for him. To my most dear friends, M. Ven. Bros. John and Robert for their friendship, deepest support, and encouragement over the last ten years.

To M. Ven. Bro. Brian, I owe my gratitude to you for your procedural and administrative guidance and assiduity, and your devotion to our beloved Allied Masonic Degrees of Canada. To Rt. Ven. Bro. Alex for your ability to put up with me, despite your coercive introductions to all that Canada had to offer masonically, and your horrifically bad puns! To Rt. Ven. Bro. Scott, we have walked a long path together and crossed so many frontiers, you have given me so much my friend. I remain perpetually in your debt my companions, for your leadership, friendship, and the examples you have set.

From joining the AMD in Vancouver, I was able to see that the structure of the order in Canada was far more open and progressive than that of the UK, and quite specifically was a unique environment for a possible solution of what I saw to be the impending, *sotto voce*, death of masonry.

A decade ago, you, my brethren, completely changed my point of view. You showed me what this most progressive and permissive masonic order could stand for, and what potential it could hold for our future. The AMD has been the only place in Canada in regular masonry where I have heard intelligent discussion about what we do, why we do it, where we come from, and where we are going to. To paraphrase what my friend John has frequently said so insightfully, the AMD is the only place where masonry may actually survive.

Where do we go from here? Bring passion into our appreciation of the AMD, enthuse pur brethren with what the AMD stands for, and what it can become. If you care as I do about our Order and what it represents, follow the leadership examples of Glenson, John, and Robert to name a few, and sing our praises from the rooftops!

What can we do as members of the Allied Masonic Degrees? We know that our new brethren joining the Craft are looking for content, hence the growth of masonic colleges and diplomas. The online collaboration among younger members is heartening, as they are trying to create what they want but cannot find within masonry.

Over the last 6 years, the academic output of the AMD has grown significantly, and we are producing an annual volume of our papers that is the envy of a number of other bodies, even if most of our members do not avail themselves of a copy of the Architect. If a council is not conferring at least one degree, nor receiving at least one paper, then I would suggest there is zero point meeting to approve the summons, minutes, and building rent. I would like to see every council that has no content on their agenda simply do something. Anything. Perhaps

read one of the papers from the Architect, and most importantly, discuss it. Receive a book report, encourage a discussion on a subject of merit, read through one of our rarely performed additional degrees. The councils which already do these things are healthy and vibrant and wonderful places to be. Those who do not threaten their own existence. Why would anyone want to join a council when an honest description of what is transacted therein is an exercise in tedium?

I believe the time has come to reinstitute the Council of the Nine Muses, as championed by M. Ven. Bro. Glenson Jones. The Nine Muses can be used as a flagship for our research output and could organise a paper to be presented at each Grand Council going forward. As a body devoted to research and education it makes little sense for us not to do so. Such a council could also act as the academic college of our order and expand our educational offerings. I see the Grand Historian, Grand Lecturer, and the Chairman of Research and Development working together within this.

Our Constitution states that we are authorised to assume control and direction of any masonic degree or rite that is not controlled in Canada by a regularly recognised masonic body. A number of valuable and interesting degrees and orders can, and perhaps should, be formally adopted into our AMD, as this will enrich our content further. For those councils who do work our other additional degrees, this will provide even more interest and enlightenment. I have charged our new Grand Lecturer to start working on this. Given that our friends in the AMD of France have already done so with the Masonic Order of St. Patrick, this would make an excellent starting point. As we have conferred a novel degree this weekend already, the precedent has been set, and we will bring another to Grand Council in Montreal next year! Brethren, this address is pointed, indeed a little inflammatory perhaps. As a surgeon I am mandated to find the problem and fix it. Sometimes the process can be painful, but the result typically justifies the means. For us to continue to grow we need to keep up with the needs of our brethren and provide something so valuable that Craft masons seek us out, and our members look forward to our meetings.

You all have my email address and phone number, and I give you my word that if you have an idea of how further to improve our Order, I will take it seriously and work with you to determine its feasibility.

Thank you my brethren for the opportunity to serve you.
